- 8) **Flies**
 - a) To note update from the Environmental Officer: 'I have visited a number of residential addresses in the village to observe fly numbers, provide fly strips and collect fly samples and will be making further visits. I have had detailed phone discussions with farm premises about treatment programmes since receipt of complaints. A detailed site inspection at 2 x farm sites locally on 28 June 2024. The site has an ongoing treatment plan including larvicides for the manure, contact surface insecticides, electric fly killers, knock down treatments and fly traps. I will be continuing with enquiries about other potential sources and a further site checks/revisits in the area are planned this week....I'm aware of the [Anglian Water] site and checked there today whilst in the area with no concerns to report.'
 - b) She would like to have access to the allotments to look at composters and other areas of concern. She would like to know if there is any poultry on the allotments for biosecurity /avian flu.

- b) **Trees for Connectivity:** <https://www.north-norfolk.gov.uk/news/2023/december/trees-for-connectivity/>. An initiative of the County Council which allows residents access to free trees in certain areas. Anyone planting within the selected areas can apply for funding. Planting could be for a community project, on a farm or in a garden. You just need permission from the landowner. The campaign can fund a wide range of plantings, including orchards, hedgerows, individual trees and small groups of trees. The campaign can't fund larger woodland planting. A resident has suggested that this is something for the Parish Council to consider.
