PROBLEM WITH FLIES IN GREAT SNORING VILLAGE

The Parish Council has been asked by Parishioners for help in dealing with the problem of flies in the village. It has been agreed to set up a Working Group of Parish Councillors and residents (more information in the newsletter). The Environmental Health at North Norfolk District Council have the statutory responsibility to deal with this problem, but it is hoped that we can help them to locate and investigate all possible sources of flies. It was, therefore, decided at the recent Parish Council meeting to send out a village-wide survey similar to the one of January 2023.

Overleaf is a short survey for you to complete to help build an accurate picture of the extent of the problem, and to indicate possible locations for the Environmental Health Team to investigate.

Please fill it in even though you might have been relatively fly free, it may be that where the flies weren't is as important as where they were. All information will be treated in the strictest confidence and in accordance with the Parish Council's Data Protection Policy (available to view on the website – details above).

Once we have all the replies, we will share it with Environmental Health. Hopefully, working together, the source(s) of the flies will be identified and action taken so that everyone can enjoy their homes during the summer months.
